# Tips from your friends at the Wrightwood Fire Safe Council.....

**Question:** What's wrong with putting pine needles out during your weekly trash pickup?

**Answer:** Pine needles put out for trash pickup by CR&R go into a landfill and dump fees are paid by CR&R.

**Solution:** All green waste brought to the Pine Needle and Green Waste Drop Off on May 2nd - May 9th are recycled, all fees are waived and it helps SB County comply with Solid Waste Reduction laws.

**Question:** Why is it so important to clean pine needles, twigs and branches off roofs and rain gutters?

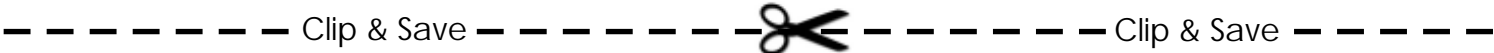
**Answer:** Structures within the wildland are not lost from direct flame, but rather from the ember environment. Embers may precede the flaming fire front, carried by the winds and distributing burning embers over long distances. These embers fall, or are wind driven into receptive fuels at structures, often going undetected for some time.

**Solution:** Keep rain gutters and roofs clear of pine needles, twigs and branches and don't forget reducing pine needles to two inches (2") or less in depth surrounding structures. A thin layer of pine needles helps retain moisture in the soil.

**Question:** What is one of the biggest issues facing emergency responders in this area?

**Answer:** Emergency responders have problems locating homes due to hidden or no Street Number being displayed. This significant factor can waste valuable seconds or minutes when responding to your home for a medical or fire emergency.

**Solution:** Street Address Numbers must be at least 4" in height, visible from the legal access road and should be illuminated at night.
