June 2012 Tri-Community Green Waste Recycling & Defensible Space Demonstration House

This year the green waste recycling event was moved to the beginning of June for warmer weather and to coincide with SB County Code Enforcement Defensible Space Demonstration House. Hundreds of residents attended the Demonstration House and learned how to create proper defensible space around their homes.

While folks were talking with agency representatives about fire abatement hazards at the Demonstration House, dozens of other residents got a jump on dropping off their green waste and set a record attendance with 277 vehicle loads on opening day.

After the 9 day Green Waste Recycling event ended the totals were tallied and it was obvious that hundreds of Tri-Community residents participated in the most successful Green Waste Recycling event in San Bernardino County history. Over ½ million pounds were recycled during the 9 day event at NO Cost to residents.

The Green Waste Recycling has now exceeded 1.8 million pounds in its 6th year.
