## 2013 Tri-Community Green Waste Program

This year's green waste recycling faced new challenges before the gates were ever opened. With tipping fees (dump charges) no longer being available through San Bernardino County Land Use, San Bernardino County Fire was able to cover tipping fees using funds from bark beetle grant money. Another challenge was how the new metal building in the county transportation yard would effect the traffic flow that had previously worked so well.

The San Gabriel Mountains have experienced well below normal precipitation for the 2nd year in a row with fine flashy fuels (grasses & weeds) much less prevalent during Spring 2013. That didn't slow down residents from making this year the 2nd largest green collection in its 7 year history.

With over 300,000 lbs collected in 2013, the Green Waste Recycling program has now exceeded 2.1 million pounds.

Based on approx 3,000 street address parcels (structures) in the community:

- Over the 7 year period that equals 707 lbs of green waste for all 3,000 street addresses Or
- 100 lbs per year, for every street address parcel (structures) for 7 consecutive years

We'd like to thank the dozens of volunteers, crews from CERT, CR&R, SBCFD Slash Crew, SB County Code Enforcement, SBCFD, SB County Public Works, Mile High Pizza and Mountain Hardware for making these events so successful!
