### Meeting Minutes

**Call to Order:** The general meeting for the Wrightwood Fire Safe Council (WFSC) was called to order by Chuck Carroll on September 18, 2012 at 1900 hours local time, at 6000 Cedar, Wrightwood, CA 92397.

**Approval of minutes:** The minutes of the August 2012 meeting were approved as written. A motion to approve was made by Joyce Harrison. Motion seconded by John Aziz. Motion passed 7/0.

#### Cooperative Partner & Agency Updates:

Angeles National Forest: No report.

San Bernardino National Forest (Lauren Blake): As we enter the fall season, expect more "Santa Ana" conditions, which will bring dry, windy days, increasing fire risk. Volunteers working with as part

of the Urban Conservation Corps are currently performing a "wilderness inventory", visiting and documenting the condition of various trails, camps, and other features within the forest.

Forest Care Program: 80 appointments to date in the Wrightwood area. 18 Wrightwood projects are currently underway.

Cal Fire (Debbie Chapman): Discussed several small fires in recent weeks. With the exception of the Williams fire, this has a slow month for CalFire in this area. Paul Camarena has retired. CWPP status: A website has been created. No templates written yet. The Wrightwood ambulance service subscription is still closed and not accepting application yet. The fee structure has been revised.

LA County Fire: No report.

SB County Fire (Dan Filter): Statistics for August: 97 calls total (41 in Wrightwood, 31 to Phelan, 23 to Pinon Hills, 2 to LA County). Other stations responded to Wrightwood 9 times.

SB County Hazardous Tree (Chris Danyow): Wright Mountain Road contract has been awarded to treat approximately 108 acres. Work should begin within 1 week. Another 230 acre project in the West Cajon Valley area has also been awarded, with work to begin within a few weeks. Another 220 acre project in the same area will also begin within a week. Work in the Wild Horse Canyon project continues. 1200 acres in the Mormon Rocks area will be treated soon.

SB County Code Enforcement: No report.

LA County Agricultural Commission (David Braklin): Competed two of the three fuels reduction projects in the Wrightwood area.

**Treasurer's Report:** No treasurer's report was submitted, since there was no activity during the last month.

**Old Business:** No additional news on the California Fire Fee implementation

**New Business:** None

**Adjournment:** The meeting was adjourned at 2022 hours local time. The next general WFSC meeting will be held on October 16, 2012.
