## Meeting Minutes

**Call to Order:** The general meeting for the Wrightwood Fire Safe Council (WFSC) was called to order by John Bauer on June 17, 2014 at 1900 hours local time, at 6000 Cedar, Wrightwood, CA 92397.

**Roll Call:** The following WFSC Board of Directors were present: John Aziz, John Bauer, Robert Comperini, Tom Delgado, Jim Emery, Glenn Goldstein, Bruce LaClaire, Patrick Martin, Kathy Smith. The following board members were absent: Chuck Carroll, Hank Hallmark, Al Morrissette.

The following agency representatives were present: Jeff Birchfield (SB County Fire), Brian Skerston (ANF), Mark Wright (SB County Fire).

**Flag Salute:** The flag salute was led by Bruce LaClaire.

**Public Comments and Questions:** None

### **Cooperative Partner & Agency Updates:**

Angeles National Forest (Brian Skerston): Discussed current staffing levels. Discussed support provided to recent fire on Lone Pine Canyon Road. ANF was first on scene.

San Bernardino National Forest: No report.

LA County Fire: No report.

SB County Fire (Jeff Birchfield): Discussed support provided to recent fire on Lone Pine Canyon Road. May stats: 84 total calls including 38 in Wrightwood, 23 to Phelan, 20 to Pinon Hills, 3 to LA County. New Ambulance subscription service fees will be \$65 per household. This change is a county-wide change that standardizes the rates for all county areas.

Cal Fire: No report.

LA County Agricultural Commission: No report.

SB County Code Enforcement: No report. John Aziz indicated that they are still working on locating a demo house for 2014.

Green Waste Event update submitted by John Aziz: 2014 was a pivotal year for this event, as there was no funding available as in past years (for fees, labor, etc). This year, Mountain High got permission to allow pine needles to be spread on their property for erosion control. Inmate crews provided much of the labor. This year, amount of waste collected was reduced from previous year. This year, 1065 vehicles made deposits. 2014 totals: 34 forty yard bins, 1,360 cubic yards, 184,000 pounds, 92.04 tons. 8 year totals: 14,650 cubic yards, 1,154.03 tons, 2,308,060 pounds. The WFSC thanks the many volunteers and cooperative partners that made this event possible.

Bark Beetle update submitted by John Aziz: Infected trees in the Oak/Blackbird and the upper Heath Creek wash areas have been removed. Cal Fire crews continue to remove infected trees in Wrightwood.

**Approval of minutes:** The minutes of the May 2014 meeting were approved as written. A motion to approve was made by John Aziz. Motion seconded by Jim Emery. Motion passed 9/0.

**Treasurer's Report:** Beginning Balance: \$9,985.45. Several checks and deposits were made this period. Ending Balance: \$16,409.75.
