Meeting Minutes

Call to order: The general meeting for the Wrightwood Fire Safe Council (WFSC) was called to order by Jim Emery on January 16, 2018 at 1900 hours local time, at 6000 Cedar, Wrightwood, CA 92397.

Roll call: The following WFSC Board of Directors were present: John Aziz, Robert Comperini, Jim Emery, Hank Hallmark, Terri Hill, Bruce LaClaire, Kathy Smith. Absent, was: Ben Smith.

The following agency representatives were present: Lauren Blake (San Bernardino National Forest), Henry Herrera (Cal Fire), Matt Kirkhart (Cal Fire), Chris Matthews (ANF), Elena Miranda (SB County Code Enforcement).

Flag salute: The flag salute was led by Jim Emery.

Public comments and questions: None

Mountain High fundraiser: February 25, 2018. Tickets are good for the remainder of the season. Tickets were handed out to FSC board members.

Wrightwood fuel mitigation projects: Chris Matthews briefed the FSC on the status of the areas that have been, or are to be treated. Pile burning along Big Pines Highway will resume once moisture levels increase. Lauren Blake recapped progress made in the Lone Pine Canyon/Boundary Ridge areas that took place in the 2005-2008 timeframe. There are no projects scheduled for the Lone Pine Canyon area in 2018. Pile burning within the San Bernardino National Forest is also on hold.

Approval of minutes: The minutes of the November 21, 2017 meeting were approved as written. A motion to approve was made by John Aziz. Motion seconded by Terri Hill. Motion passed 7/0.

Chuck Carroll: The FSC received Chuck's resignation. Chuck has moved out of the local area. The FSC thanks Chuck for his many years of service to the FSC.

Cooperative partner & agency updates:

Angeles National Forest (Chris Matthews): No additional report.

San Bernardino National Forest (Lauren Blake): No additional report.

Cal Fire (Henry Herrera): Henry discussed various "Forest Health" and "Urban Communities" grants that are available. These can be used for fuels reductions. A suspect was charged with arson for 11 fires that have started in near the Devore area.

LA County Fire: No report.

SB County Fire: No report.

SB County Code Enforcement (Elena Miranda): In 2017, property inspections resulted in 323 notices being sent out. Those resulted in 93 citations being issued with 42 abatements. Elena discussed the basic process of their inspection program. She also discussed the appeals process. The 2018 property inspections will begin in the late springtime.

LA County Agricultural Commission: No report.

Treasurer's report: Annual reports for both 2016 and 2017 were presented. In the beginning of 2016, the FSC's balance was \$18,986.83. At the end of 2016, the balance was \$6,280.72. In the beginning of 2017, the FSC's balance was \$6,280.72. At the end of 2017, the balance was \$7,743.71.

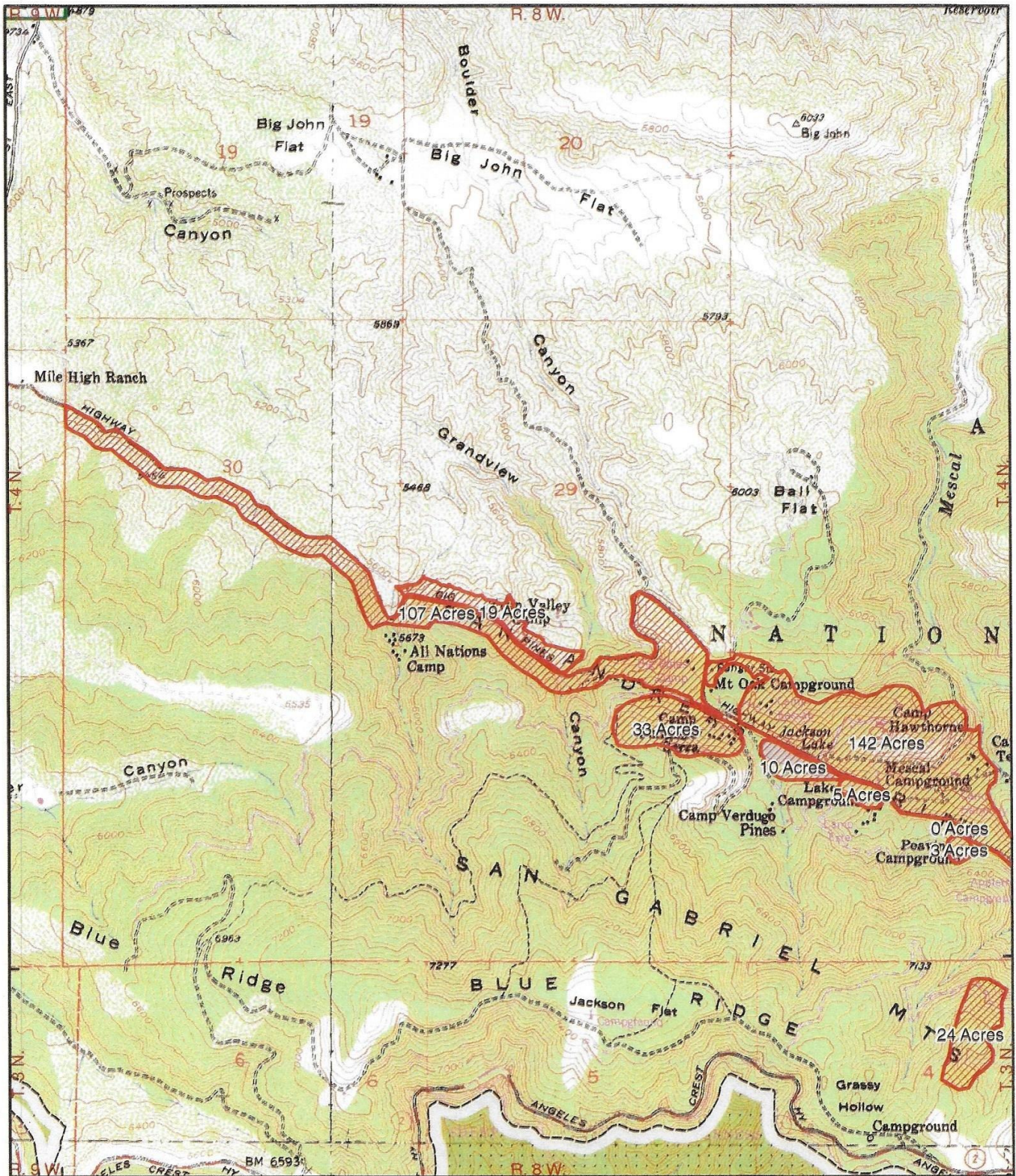
New/continued business: None

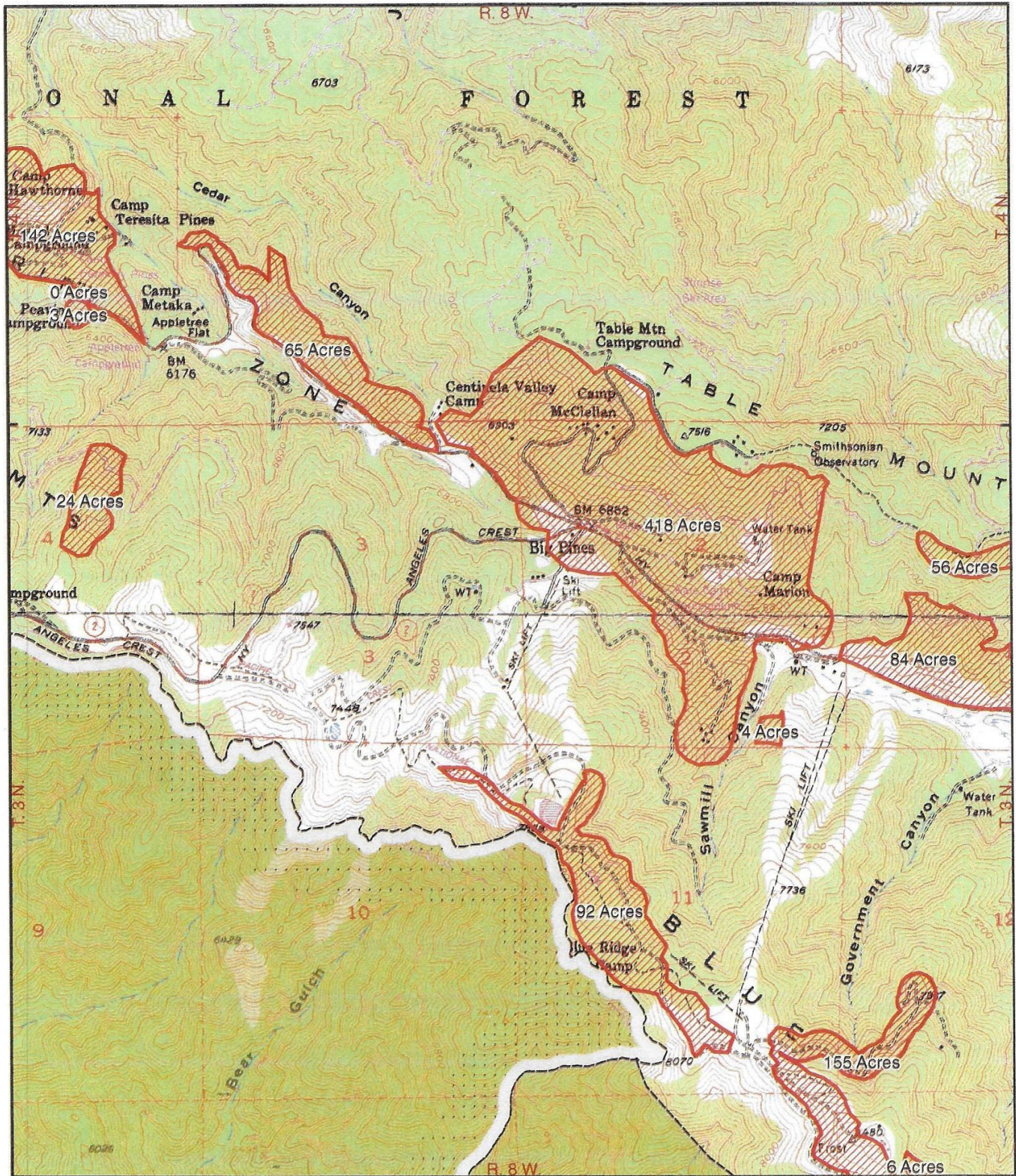

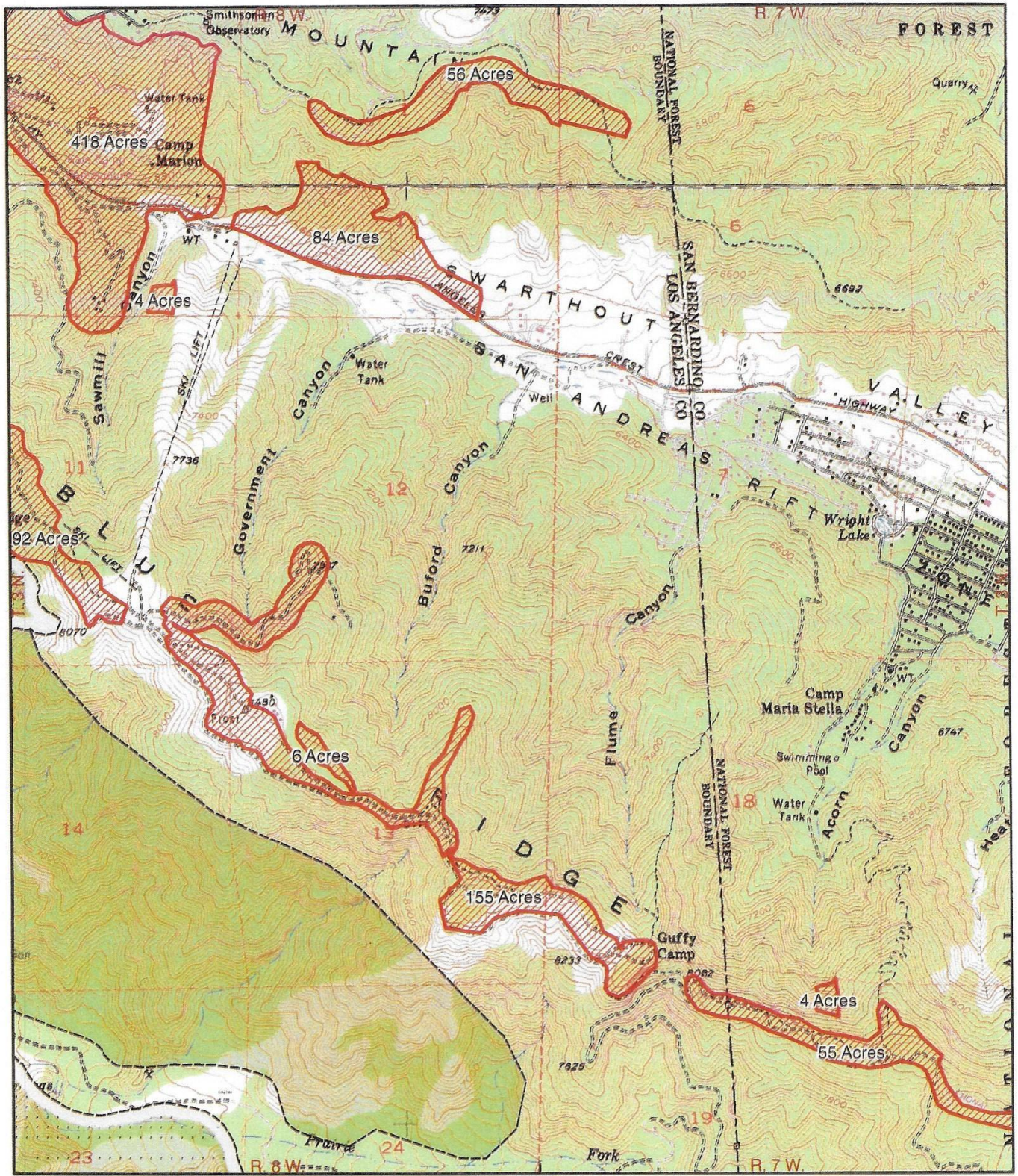

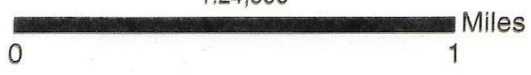




Burn Plan Project Maps



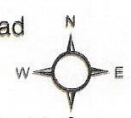

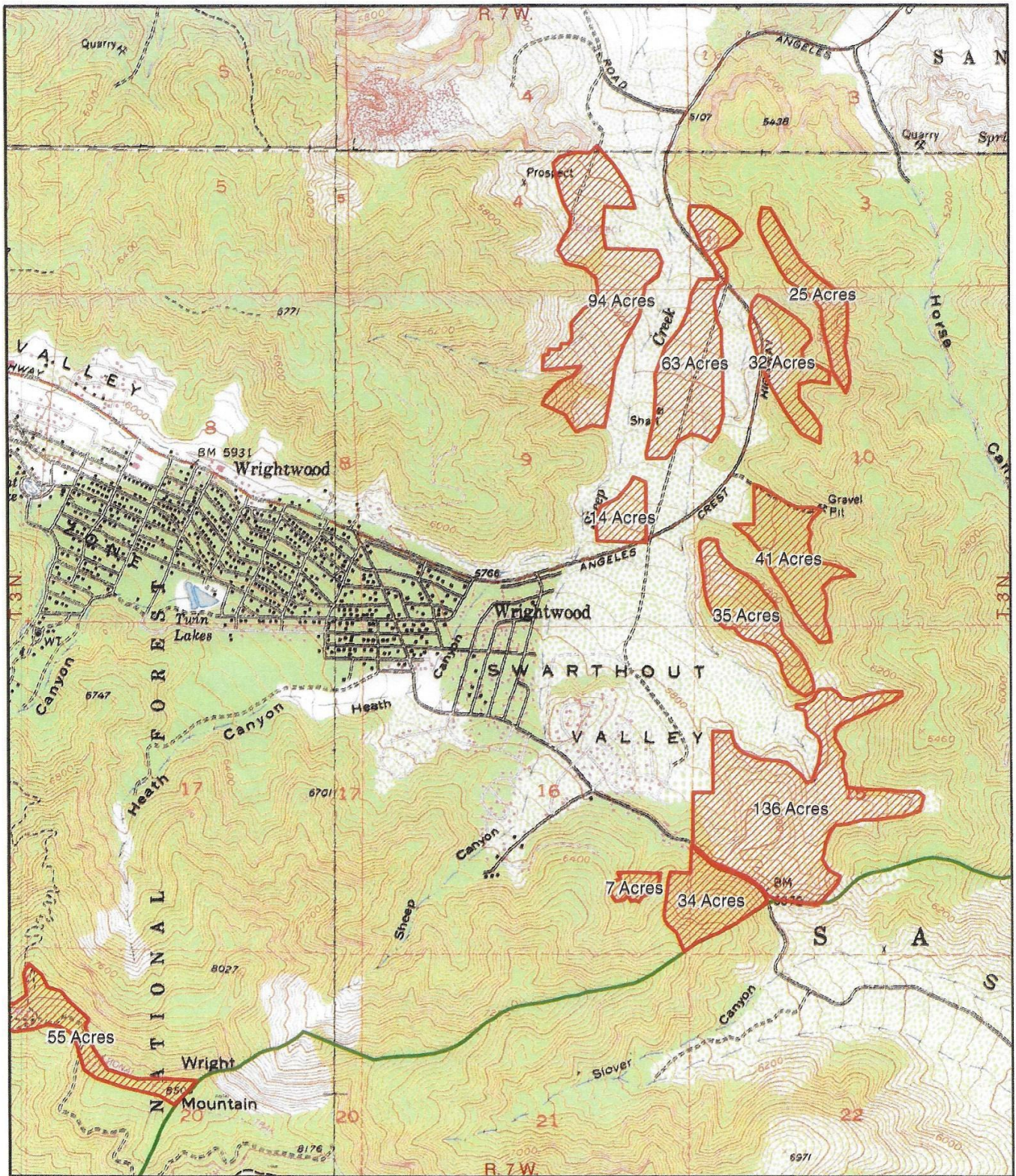
