Meeting Minutes

Call to order: The general meeting for the Wrightwood Fire Safe Council (WFSC) was called to order by Jim Emery on June 19, 2018 at 1900 hours local time, at 6000 Cedar, Wrightwood, CA 92397.

Roll call: The following WFSC Board of Directors were present: John Aziz, Robert Comperini, Jim Emery, Terri Hill, Kathy Smith. Absent, was: Hank Hallmark, Bruce LaClaire, Ben Smith.

The following agency representatives were present: Matt Kirkhart (Cal Fire), Chris Matthews (ANF), Elena Miranda (SBC Fire Hazardous Abatement), Capt. Wright (SB County Fire)

Flag salute: The flag salute was led by Kathy Smith.

Public comments and questions: None

Green Waste Recycling Event Recap (John Aziz): 2018 stats: 37 bins, 1,480 cubic yards, 242.5 tons (485,000 pounds). Inmate crews did an excellent job. We had the same crew all week, which meant we did not have to train new crews during the week. This year, they put all needles on the ground, and inspected them before putting into bins. Mountain High reports that pine needle material delivered this year was much cleaner as a result of this. The WFSC thanks CR&R for their support, providing the bins and transportation. The WFSC has to rent two porta-potties, sodas, water, ice, mailings, lunch one day for crew, etc. Net deposit was \$1,281.

CSD Fee Waiver Update (John Aziz): At the last CSD meeting, the WFSC had submitted a waiver application for our normal monthly meeting, and the winter traffic meeting. Both waivers were approved, and the WFSC will not be charged for use of the facility.

CWPP Update (John Aziz): No update

Approval of minutes: The minutes of the May 2018 meeting were approved as written. A motion to approve was made by Jim Emery. Motion seconded by Terri Hill. Motion passed 5/0.

Cooperative partner & agency updates:

Anges National Forest (Chris Matthews): SOPA available on website for public comment. The ANF recently had a fast moving fire near Acton. Antelope Valley College fire tech students will be doing some hand-line work near Ball Flat Road this week. Although this is a training exercise, it does benefit the forest.

San Bernardino National Forest: No report.

Cal Fire (Mat Kirkhart): Currently reading fire prevention grant applications that were submitted. Local stations are at full peak staffing for fire season. A small vegetation fire near the runaway truck ramp on the southbound I-15 appears to have been caused by fireworks.

LA County Fire: No report.

SB County Fire (Capt. Wright): At normal staffing levels. All equipment is working. Capt Wright discussed a recent vegetation fire in Wrightwood that resulted in a complaint. The complaint lodged said that the fire department took too long to respond. Station 14 was in Phelan on a call at the time. The covering unit (station 10) responded within 15 minutes. A resident was using some kind of torch on their driveway, and accidentally caused juniper bushes to ignite. Fire was out by the time the fire department arrived.

SB County Code Enforcement (Elena Miranda): Wrightwood property inspections began on 6/14/2018. Inspections should conclude on 6/20/2018. Reports indicate a higher than normal number of violations. Notices to resident should go out within 7-10 days. Elena will provide statistics at the next WFSC meeting.

LA County Agricultural Commission: No report.

Treasurer's report: Terri is working with QuickBooks now. Beginning balance when Terri took over as treasurer: \$13,792.70. Ending balance: \$11,855.97

New/continued business: John Aziz gave an update on his NRCS project. John is getting 15 acres treated (mastication, and tree/shrub pruning). John receives approval for funding, and will be reimbursed when the treatment has been completed.

Adjournment: The meeting was adjourned at 2006 hours local time. The next general WFSC meeting will be held on July 17, 2018.
