## Meeting Minutes

**Call to order:** The general meeting for the Wrightwood Fire Safe Council (WFSC) was called to order by Jim Emery on September 18, 2018 at 1900 hours local time, at 6000 Cedar, Wrightwood, CA 92397.

**Flag salute:** The flag salute was led by Jim Emery.

**Public comments and questions:** Terri Hill announced that she will be doing something to recognize first responders for "First Responders Day". Patrick Martin announced that the local library now has protest forms for the proposed FP-5 tax.

**Hazardous waste recycling event:** Will be held September 29, 2018 from 9:00am to 1:00pm at the County yard in Wrightwood.

# Tri-Community Green Waste Recycling

September 2018 update

This year an additional late summer recycling event was added giving residents an opportunity to clear properties of hazardous pine needles. The two day event was well attended with 204 vehicle loads recycling 29.5 tons. This additional 59,000 pounds of pine needles brings the 2018 green waste recycling total to over 1/2 million pounds. (544,000 pounds)
