This year marks the 18th annual Green Waste Recycling event, proudly sponsored by the Wrightwood Fire Safe Council

2026 Event Highlights

- **Participation:** 833 vehicle loads contributed to this year's event.
- **Impact:** 97.66 tons (195,320 pounds) of hazardous fuels were safely recycled.
- **Volunteers:** Our success is thanks to dozens of dedicated volunteers and the support of organizations including WW CERT, WCSD, CR&R, SBCFD, SB County Public Works, Mountain High, Mountain Hardware, CALFIRE, and Snowline School District.

- **Total since inception:** Over **5,26247,980 pounds** (2,624 tons) of green waste recycled!
